


You are studying extinct animals in the English class at your high school. Your teacher assigned you to research them and make a presentation. You find a website that explains extinct animals.

Extinct Animals	
 <p>Chinese River Dolphin</p> <p>Habitat: The Yangtze River in China Reasons for extinction: As China industrialized, the river was used for fishing, transportation, and hydroelectricity, which had a huge effect on the mammals. Extinction: Although not officially recorded as extinct, no one has seen a Yangtze River Dolphin since 2002.</p>	 <p>Western Black Rhinoceros</p> <p>Habitat: In several countries towards the southeast region of Africa Reasons for extinction: Some people believed their horns had medicinal properties — though this had no grounding in scientific fact — which led to heavy illegal hunting. Extinction: It was declared officially extinct in 2011.</p>
 <p>Tasmanian Tiger</p> <p>Habitat: Australia, Tasmania, and New Guinea Reasons for extinction: It is believed to have been hunted to extinction, but human invasion into its habitat, the introduction of dogs, and disease could also have contributed. Extinction: The last wild Tasmanian Tiger was killed between 1910 and 1920, and the last captive one died in 1936.</p>	 <p>Great Auk</p> <p>Habitat: In the North Atlantic and as far south as Northern Spain Reasons for extinction: When a large storm surged, people believed that the auk was a witch and was causing the storm, so they killed it. Extinction: The last of these birds was killed by three men in 1844.</p>
